Welcome

The management and staff of The Misquamicut Club welcome you back for the 2020 season. Please take a moment to review the 2020 calendar for event dates, policies and other important information.

Guest Policy

Our Guest Policy provides for a total of five (5) times per year for any non-family guest and six (6) times per year for an immediate family (non-member) guest, regardless of whether or not the person is an overnight houseguest.

Member Guests

Non-family guests of Club Members are permitted to use the Club in any form (golf, tennis, beach club, dining or event participation) for a maximum of five (5) visits per year. Immediate family guests may utilize the Club facilities a maximum of six (6) visits per year. Immediate family are children, parents, siblings and grandchildren of members. There is no differentiation between overnight guests and non-overnight guests. This includes any time a person, his or her spouse or under 18-year-old child visits any Club property, regardless of where they stayed the night and whether the person has been a guest of more than one member. To be clear, this policy applies to both non-family (5) and immediate family (6) guest visits, respectively, taking into account all members visited, but excluding strictly private events (see below).

Guest Books

All guests must be signed in by a Member at any time and at all Club locations where a guest visits. Club Guest Books are located at the Beach Club (entry way and service ramp), Golf Club House (front entryway door), Golf Course (the starter's podium at the first tee) and Tennis (in the Tennis Pro Shop). We trust that the staff will not be required to remind the Member of this strict requirement. As a Member, please be sure that your guest has not inadvertently or otherwise exceeded the maximum visit limitations.

Absentee Members

At the beginning of each calendar year, Members are generally permitted to elect Absentee status for the upcoming season. For the reduced annual dues payable by an Absentee, he or she is permitted to use the Club in any form (golf, tennis, beach club, dining or event participation) for a maximum of seven (7) times per year (excluding strictly private events). This includes any time a person, his or her spouse or under 18-year-old child visits the premises, whether under the parent's membership or as a guest of any other Member.

“Day” or “Visit” Examples

Below are examples of what counts as a “day” or “visit” to the Club for both guests and Absentee Members.

- Use of the beach; having breakfast, lunch or dinner at any Club property.
- Attendance at a Club sponsored dinner dance or entertainment event, including the 4th of July celebration and Misquamicooks.

- Playing golf with a Member, as an unaccompanied guest or in a Member-Guest Tournament or Club sponsored Invitational Tournament. This includes The Heminway Bowl - both golf and social events.
- Playing tennis with a Member, as an unaccompanied guest or in a Member Guest Tournament or Club sponsored Invitational Tournament, or as part of a private lesson or clinic.
- Use of the Club's guest rooms.
- Playing card or board games, as well as the instruction thereof.

Frequently Asked Questions

If a Guest plays golf, eats lunch, plays tennis and then comes to a Club event at night for dinner, how many visits does that constitute? If all of the events happen on the same day, it is one visit. If the events are on separate days, they would each count as separate “days” or “visits”.

What if a husband plays golf on the same day that his wife plays tennis and his children go to the beach club? It counts as one visit. The result differs if any of the above occurs on separate days.

Examples of what does NOT count as a “Day” or “Visit”:

- Attendance as an invited guest to a Member sponsored private party where the Member reserves a significant Club space for his or her invitees. Example: rehearsal dinner, wedding reception or cocktail party held at either the Golf Club or Beach Club.
- Attendance at the Heminway Bowl past Champions dinner.

- Playing as a guest at a large scale, private, nonprofit, or member hosted golf outing or invitational (e.g., Vogt/Bryan private invitational, Mystic Aquarium golf outing).

Children

- While at any facility, children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent, caregiver or other adult. Exceptions are adult Member chaperoned or Club supervised events.
- Children are not permitted to play in the Clubhouse. Particular care should be taken with smaller children in all dining areas.

Smoking

- Per the State of Rhode Island law and Club policy, smoking is prohibited inside any building at The Misquamicut Club. Smoking is not permitted on the beach, but is permitted in the Club parking lots. The same policy applies to the use of e-cigarettes or “vapors.”
- Smoking in any form is not allowed on any porch or terrace at the Clubhouse.

Business

- Members and Guests shall refrain from conducting business on Club grounds.

Cell Phones, Laptops, Electronic Devices

- Talking on cell phones is prohibited on Club property, with the exceptions of parking lots and guest rooms. Text messaging on cell phones, or personal electronic devices, is allowed providing it doesn't distract Members or Guests. All electronic devices shall be set to silent mode at all times on Club property.

Photography and Social Media Policy

The Club is a distinctly private institution and all members should therefore have an expectation of privacy while on Club property. No member, guest, or employee shall be photographed without the member's, guest's, or employee's consent. Photographs of the Club or its members, guests, and employees shall not be used for commercial purposes without the written approval of the Club through its General Manager.

Posts on Social Media such as Facebook and Instagram are permitted; however, members must act with discretion and not post the names or images of members, guests, or employees without their permission. Members should consider how posts reflect on the Club and its members and exercise proper decorum with regard to photography and social media descriptions.

If a photograph, video or other depiction of a Misquamicut Club member, guest, employee, or of the Club's facilities is taken or made on Club property, it is a violation of Club policy for the Club to be “tagged” or “geolocated” and

publicly posted on a website, social network site or similar communication medium (Facebook, Instagram, etc.) without prior written approval of the General Manager.

Social entertaining at the Club is welcomed, but as the Club is private in nature, press coverage of social events is strictly prohibited.

It is the responsibility of the members to inform their guests of this photography and social media policy.

Alcoholic Beverages

- No persons under 21 years of age will be served or allowed to consume alcoholic beverages on any Club premises.
- Club Staff and Management reserve the right to refuse the service of alcoholic beverages to any Member or Guest who (1) cannot provide satisfactory evidence that he or she is 21 years of age or (2) appears to be intoxicated.
- Alcoholic beverages purchased at the Club may not be taken off the Club property.
- No alcoholic beverages may be consumed on Club premises except those served by the Club. The exception to this rule is bottled wine, which is subject to a \$20 per bottle “corkage fee.”
- Please be advised that bar closing hours are at the discretion of club management.

Dress Codes & Attire

(unless otherwise stated for special events)

Club Room and Terrace Attire:

- Men: Tucked-in collared shirts. No jackets or ties required. Golf attire and shorts are permitted.
- Ladies: Blouse, turtleneck, sweater, or similar top. Slacks or skirt with appropriate top.
- Hats must be removed upon entering the Clubhouse.
- Blue jeans are NOT permitted in the Clubhouse June 1 through Labor Day.

Clubhouse Dining Room Attire:

- Men – Jacket/blazer, no tie, slacks, collared shirt.
- Women – Skirts and dress slacks with appropriate top.

Beach Club Formal Deck Lunch Attire:

- Men – Casual attire. NO bathing suits.
- Women – Casual attire. NO bathing suits or sheer coverups.

Beach Club Formal Deck Dinner Attire:

- Men – Jacket/blazer, no tie, slacks, collared shirt.
- Women – Skirts or dress slacks with appropriate top.

Beach Club Blue Jeans:

- NO blue jeans June 19 through Labor Day (with the exception of Misquamicooks).
- White jeans for ladies are permitted.

Golf Dress Code:

- Men: Slacks or full length Bermuda/walking shorts with a collared shirt.
- Ladies: Slacks, Bermuda/walking shorts/skirts, sport shirt or blouse. Shorts no shorter than just above the knee.

Hats must be worn with bill forward. No jeans, cut-offs, cargo pants/ shorts, bare midriffs, tennis, workout or bathing attire are permitted. Appropriate golf shoes are required on the course and practice facilities, with the exception of Juniors playing in clinics, where tennis shoes are acceptable.

Tennis Dress Code:

All white tennis attire is required while playing tennis. This includes hats, shoes, socks, and warm up attire.

- Men/Boys: white collared shirts (tucked in) and tennis shorts with minimal trim color.
- Women/Girls: white tennis outfits. Minimal trim color.
- White t-shirts with the MC Club logo are acceptable.
- White hats/visors worn with the bill facing forward.
- White tennis shoes with non-marking soles.
- Staff has the authority to enforce dress code violations.

July Fourth Seating

July 4th Dinner & Fireworks seating is divided into 2 areas, East and West, each containing approx. 90 tables. Members must register for the table drawing by 5pm on June 27. When registering on the Club website or with Angie (email angie@themisquamicutclub.com), Members are asked to request East/West seating and provide the names (and number) of people seated at their table(s). Families wishing to be seated at adjacent tables should indicate this preference. Each table/group is assigned a number to be randomly drawn after the registration deadline. As numbers are drawn, tables are assigned to Members in East or West areas. Following the table assignment process, the Club will post a list of table numbers and Members assigned to each table. Table numbers with Member name(s) will be secured to each table. Members requesting a table after June 27 will be assigned a table from the remaining seating not assigned in the draw.

Safety

Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing. Players shall not play until the players in the group in front are well out of range.

Players shall not hit a ball over the driving range fence and must follow all posted rules regarding use of the range without exception.

Lightning

At the sound of the lightning alert, it is mandatory for all persons on the golf course to seek lightning shelter at the Clubhouse immediately. When the threat of lightning has left the area, the system will sound 10 short blasts.

Pace of Play

Players should keep up with the group in front of them. If a group delays the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through. If a player believes his ball may be lost outside a water hazard or is out of bounds, he should play a provisional ball. The Golf Committee believes that, under normal conditions, a 4-ball round of golf should be played in under 4 hours. Golf etiquette

dictates that a faster group playing behind a slower group should be allowed to play through. The term "group" also includes a single player.

USGA Rules

Club events are played in accordance with USGA rules. Applicable local rules are posted on the information board and distributed prior to events. The Golf Committee is supportive of the USGA's "Tee It Forward" program and encourages all golfers to play from the proper set of tees for their game.

Care of the Course

Golfers are expected to repair ball marks on greens, replace divots, rake bunkers and pickup/remove broken tees.

Children

No child under the age of 12 should be in the Men's or Ladies' locker rooms at the Golf Club unaccompanied.

Caddies

Caddies and Forecaddies are available during weekends and tournaments in July and August. Reserve a caddy with the starter, Pro Shop or Fore Tees system.

Spikeless Play

Only non-metal spikes are allowed on the golf course and practice facilities.

Golf Carts

Exercise extreme caution in the operation of golf carts at all times. Keep carts 30 feet from Greens. Carts should follow signs/ropes and be driven on the cart paths. Golf carts may not be rented/operated by individuals under 16 years of age. Every golf cart operator must hold a valid driver's license. The Club assumes no responsibility for accidents or damage caused by golf carts.

Golf Guest Rules

Unaccompanied Guests are discouraged from playing on weekends or holidays July 1 through Labor Day. No Guest may play more than 5 times in 1 year. A Member may introduce a maximum of 7 guests in 1 day provided a Member plays with the Guests (2 foursomes). Maximum of 7 Guests applies to 1 Membership only and not to each member of the family. Sign in all guests in the Guest Book on the 1st tee. Members should refrain from bringing the maximum of 7 guests on weekends/holidays July 1st through Labor Day

Etiquette

- Please repair your ball mark and one other on every green
- Use the seed and soil mix to help fill your divots in the fairway and rough
- Please keep all carts out of the high grass areas
- Be ready to play when it's your turn
- Keep the golf carts at least 30 feet from greens, tees, and bunkers
- Please rake bunkers and enter/exit at the low end and try not to walk up the bunker face

Etiquette

- Do not walk across the back of another court or cross onto another court until players have finished playing a point.
- Speak quietly when standing near a court where others are playing. Never scream or yell.
- Spectators may applaud good shots of both competitors and must remain off the court during matches. Spectators are not allowed to coach or discuss any matter with a player during a match. Spectators may not assist with scoring or line calls.

Tournaments & Labor Day Prize Events

- Only Members are eligible to participate in Labor Day prize events.
- For "Parent-Child" events, Members are encouraged to play with their children and adhere to the literal meaning of "parent-child".
- Juniors, who are Club Champions at the most senior level, may participate in adult Club Championship tournaments. Otherwise, participation in adult tournaments is limited to those 17 and older.

Facility Care

- No food is allowed on the courts. If you bring a drink onto the court, be sure to take it with you when you leave and dispose of it properly.
- After eating at the snack bar, Members, their children and caretakers are required to dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles. If you see trash left behind, please pick it up and dispose of it.
- Do not leave any balls on the court when play is finished. Return balls to the tennis hoppers or, if you brought balls, take them when you leave.

USTA Rules

- Players must follow rules in the Tennis Code established by the USTA (United States Tennis Association).

Lightning

- The Club has the Strike Guard Lightning Detection. When lightning is detected within 5 miles of the Club, a

horn will sound. It is mandatory to seek lightning shelter immediately. The lightning shelter areas are the Tennis Pavilion and the Clubhouse. When the threat of lightning has left the area, the system will sound 10 short blasts.

Behavior Guidelines

- Any form of obvious cheating at making line calls will not be tolerated.
- Racquet abuse is not acceptable at any time.
- Hitting balls into the woods or onto another court in anger is not acceptable.
- Use of profanity will not be tolerated. Shouting is not acceptable at the tennis courts.
- Players must show respect at all times to their fellow players and the professional staff. Any form of verbal or physical abuse or inappropriate remarks or gestures will not be tolerated.
- Behavior guidelines apply to adults and juniors while playing home or away. Please set a good example.

Reservations:

Court Times, Lessons, Clinics

- Members are encouraged to book court time, lessons, and clinics using the Club's website or by calling the Pro Shop in advance.

Ladder Matches

- The tennis "ladder" is maintained by the Tennis Professional Staff. Parents are encouraged to support their children in their efforts to arrange regular ladder matches. Participation and ranking in the ladder is the basis of participating in junior team matches.

Junior Team Matches

- Junior players are encouraged to sign up for matches early so Tennis Staff can organize balanced matches with participating clubs. Parents are asked to see that their children fulfill their commitment to a match.

Beach Club Parking Policy

“A” Parking Stickers allow vehicle access to Beach Club parking at all times, assuming there is an available spot. Otherwise, members will be directed to park at the Golf Club and shuttle in on the Club Shuttle.

“B” and “C” Parking Stickers allow vehicle access to Beach Club parking 7 days a week until June 27 and after Labor Day. Between June 27 and Labor Day, B & C stickers may not access the Beach Club lot on Weekends and Holidays until 3pm.

Family Memberships are issued one A and one B sticker. Family Memberships may purchase one C ‘Nanny’ sticker for \$100 for a driving age caregiver. C stickers share the same privileges as B stickers.

Guest Cardholders are given an A and/or B **CARD**, limited to predetermined time of Club use and marked accordingly.

Houseguests of Members should be driven to the Beach Club in host vehicles.

Luncheon or Beach Guests may park at the Beach Club on all B sticker days, if the hosting member provides the Beach Club staff with 24 hours advance notice of the guests’ arrival day and time. A list of expected guests will be maintained at the gate for proper entry. No name on list, no entry.

During restricted Beach Club parking times, Members and guests may park at the Golf Club. A Member Shuttle will transport Members and guests to/from the Golf Club.

Dinner Guests may park at the Beach Club any evening the Beach Club is open (with 24 hours advance notice), except at July & August Misquamicooks. Golf & Tennis Tournament guests should rely on hosts for transportation (walking and biking encouraged).

Beach Etiquette

- No food, glass or pets are permitted on the beach.
- Cell phone usage is limited to texting.
- Place all trash in appropriate refuse containers.
- Rinse feet on outside deck and do not bring sandy beach equipment into the patios.
- Showers are to be limited to no more than five minutes.
- Outdoor showers/hoses are for rinsing only, not for play.
- Remove personal belongings from patios at end of day.

- After 6pm, return chairs/umbrellas to original location.
- Members and Guests must leave the Club upon conclusion of events.

Patios

- The Men’s and Ladies’ Patios are open from 10am-6pm daily. Please do not leave personal items in the Patios overnight. Children under 12 may use the Patios only when accompanied by an adult Member or nanny.

Lost and Found

Small items may be retrieved at the Reception Desk. Please encourage children to pick up toys and other beach items.

Beach Dining

- No food, glass or pets are permitted on the beach.
- No bare feet permitted on the Formal Deck.
- No persons under age of 18 may dine on the Formal Deck unless accompanied by an adult.
- The Bay Room is intended for use by Senior Members with the exception of Sunday Night dinner. Appropriate attire required.
- Leave beach equipment, beach bags, towels, etc. in the patios when using the Formal Deck.
- Members in beach attire may dine on lower or side decks. Access these areas via the lawn.
- Members in beach attire and children may order from the Soda Window. Children, under 12, are not allowed to enter the Servery.
- Appropriate cover-ups, shirts and shoes are required in the Servery.

Beach Club Attire

Formal Deck Lunch Attire

- Men – Casual attire. NO bathing suits.
- Women – Casual attire. NO bathing suits or sheer coverups.

Formal Deck Dinner Attire

- Men – Jacket/blazer, no tie, slacks, collared shirt.
- Women – Skirts or dress slacks with appropriate top.

Blue Jeans

- NO blue jeans June 19 thru Labor Day (with the exception of Misquamicooks)
- White jeans for ladies are permitted

Misquamicook

- No Member shall place belongings on any table before 6pm on Thursday night.
- No Member shall ask any staff member to hold a table for him or her.
- Members over 70 years of age may request to reserve a table in the Bay Room. These reservations are limited and on a first come first serve basis. Reservations will be accepted beginning Monday of the given week. This policy is subject to change and availability.
- All Members are welcome to come for open seating beginning at 6pm.

Children

- Children suitably attired and accompanied by an adult Member may dine on the Formal Deck. No babies or toddlers are permitted to dine on the Formal Deck.
- Children may order from the Soda Window or Ocean Side Café.
- Children (under 12 years of age) are not permitted in the Patio areas of the Beach Club without adult supervision.
- Unaccompanied children are to use the showers provided on the Beach Deck.
- Children, regardless of age, must be appropriately attired at all times including on the beach.
- Changing Stations are provided in the Ladies' and Men's Patios. No changing is permitted on the beach.

Babysitters/Au Pairs

- Members are asked to register au pairs or sitters with the Reception Desk.
- Au pairs and sitters may be at the Club only while caring for Members' children.
- Au pairs and sitters are permitted only on the Patio Deck and the beach and may not use the Formal Deck.
- It is unacceptable for an au pair or sitter to bring friends or their own children to the Club under any circumstances.
